Introduction

Xylem Inc. (NYSE: XYL) is committed to conducting business with integrity and social responsibility across our operations and global supply chain. We believe everyone connected to our business should be treated with dignity and respect.

This statement describes the actions taken by Xylem and its subsidiaries during the financial year ending December 2025 (the "Reporting Period") to help prevent and address modern slavery risks in our operations and supply chains.

This statement is published pursuant to:

- The U.K. Modern Slavery Act 2015
- The Australia Modern Slavery Act 2018
- The California Transparency in Supply Chains Act 2010
- Canada's Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act 2023 (the "Canadian Act")

For the purposes of this statement, "modern slavery" includes forced, involuntary, or enslaved labor, child labor, servitude, and trafficked labor.

Company background and operations

Xylem Inc. (NYSE: XYL) is a Fortune 500 global water solutions company committed to addressing critical water and resource challenges through innovative solutions. With approximately 22,000 employees worldwide, we collaborate with utilities, industrial manufacturers, building operators, and communities to solve the water challenges that matter most. We connect diverse capabilities, innovative technologies, and deep expertise to provide tailored solutions across the entire water cycle. From moving, treating, and measuring water to optimizing and maintaining water systems, Xylem helps customers strengthen resilience, improve resource efficiency, and protect public health and the environment.

Supply Chain

Xylem operates a global manufacturing and assembly footprint across Europe, North America, Latin America, Asia, and the Middle East.

Our operations require a wide range of parts and raw materials, including motors, fabricated parts, castings, magnets, bearings, seals, batteries, printed circuit boards, semiconductors, steel, brass, nickel, copper, aluminum, rare earth minerals, and plastics.

We rely on third-party suppliers, contract manufacturing, and commodity markets to secure the materials, parts, and components used in our products.

Governance of modern slavery risk

Strong corporate governance is an important part of Xylem's sustainability strategy. Our governance framework is designed to support transparency, fairness, and accountability across our operations and supply chain.

Management is responsible for the day-to-day management of company risks, including compliance with applicable laws and implementation of appropriate risk management programs, policies, and practices.

Our commitment to responsible business conduct is reflected in our [Code of Conduct](#), [Human Rights Statement](#), and [Business Partner and Supply Partner Code of Conduct](#).

Assessment of modern slavery risk

Based on the locations of our operations, the nature of the work performed, and the workforce required for our operations, we believe the inherent risk of modern slavery within Xylem's directly employed workforce is very low. Many of our employees are educated or skilled workers operating in controlled environments supported by established policies and processes.

Our Business Partner and Supply Partner Code of Conduct prohibits suppliers from engaging in unlawful business practices, including any form of modern slavery. It also allows Xylem to terminate relationships with suppliers found to be engaging in such practices.

To support risk identification, Xylem uses a supplier risk mapping tool that applies automation and analytics to assess sustainability risks across our supply chain, including modern slavery risks.

Supply chain verification and supplier audits

Xylem's Business Partner and Supply Partner Code of Conduct outlines our expectations that suppliers conduct business with integrity and social responsibility.

It prohibits unlawful business practices, including the use of modern slavery. Suppliers that agree to the Business Partner and Supply Partner Code of Conduct also provide Xylem with access to facilities and relevant records associated with products and services supplied to Xylem as part of our Supplier Audit Program.

Through the Supplier Audit Program, Xylem assesses supplier processes and procedures, communication channels, sustainability practices, conflict minerals compliance, organizational capability, and logistics practices.

As part of these assessments, suppliers respond to questions related to corporate responsibility matters, including modern slavery, and may be subject to additional review where appropriate.

In 2025, Xylem took additional steps to assess supplier labor practices and evaluate the effectiveness of supplier policies. We review supplier labor and human rights practices annually using EcoVadis ratings. At the close of 2025, suppliers with active EcoVadis scorecards represented 47% of Xylem's global spend.

In 2025, Xylem also conducted three on-site audits under our Sustainability Risk Mitigation process for suppliers identified as "Sustainability High Risk" through our assessment process.

Supplier certification requirements

Xylem's standard terms and conditions of purchase include a certification prohibiting modern slavery.

By accepting these terms and conditions, suppliers certify that they will:

- Not use child labor as defined by local law
- Not use forced or compulsory labor
- Not physically abuse workers
- Respect employees' rights to choose whether to be represented by third parties and to bargain collectively in accordance with local law

Suppliers also certify compliance with applicable laws and regulations relating to wages and benefits, working hours and overtime, health and safety, and environmental matters.

Code of Conduct and training

All Xylem employees (including new employees) are required to complete various ethics and compliance-related training at least annually, including Code of Conduct awareness, anti-corruption, and other ethics and compliance-related topics. Our Code of Conduct and related policies reinforce our commitment to conducting business with integrity, in a manner that respects human dignity and supports human rights, regardless of local business customs.

Xylem reviews and updates training content from time to time to reflect evolving legal requirements, emerging risks, and lessons learned through our due diligence and compliance processes.

Accountability and reporting mechanisms

Xylem's Human Rights Statement includes commitments related to the prevention of modern slavery and provides that Xylem may take appropriate action, including termination of business relationships where warranted, if suppliers fail to comply with our policies and standards relating to modern slavery and responsible business conduct.

Xylem also maintains the [Xylem Integrity Line](#) through an independent provider. The Integrity Line supports reporting in multiple languages and offers 24-hour reporting capabilities for employees, suppliers, customers, contractors, and other third parties to report suspected violations of the Code of Conduct or Business Partner and Supply Partner Code of Conduct, or related policies, including concerns related to modern slavery. Xylem prohibits retaliation or intimidation against individuals who raise concerns or participate in an investigation in good faith.

Remediation

In 2025, Xylem did not identify forced labor or child labor within our operations or supply chains.

As a result, Xylem did not take measures to remediate adverse impacts related to forced labor or child labor, nor did we identify any loss of income to vulnerable families resulting from actions taken to eliminate forced labor or child labor.

Next steps

Xylem remains committed to maintaining a responsible and ethical supply chain.

We continue to enhance training for procurement and other employees involved in purchasing decisions to support understanding of our procurement policies, ethical standards, sustainability expectations, and compliance requirements.

Our procurement processes require supply partners to align with our business standards, product quality requirements, process capabilities, and sustainability and compliance expectations.

We will continue to assess and monitor our efforts to address modern slavery risks globally and report on our progress through this statement.

From time to time, Xylem Inc. (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through your DocuSign, Inc. (DocuSign) Express user account. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to these terms and conditions, please confirm your agreement by clicking the 'I agree' button at the bottom of this document.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. For such copies, as long as you are an authorized user of the DocuSign system you will have the ability to download and print any documents we send to you through your DocuSign user account for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. Consequences of changing your mind
